Teaching Practice (Practicum)

In semester 2, the trainees will be sent for teaching practice for 6 weeks in higher secondary or middle secondary schools. They will teach 3-4 periods daily. They will write daily lesson plans and analysis reports of the lessons observed. They will write Teaching Practice Reflections. The associate teachers and the supervising lecturers will supervise them. They will put the theories learnt into practice, and gain experience in teaching. Their notional efforts will be 120 hours (12 credits), equivalent to one module.
